To: ALL CUSTOMERS SERVICED BY CLEAR LAKE CITY WATER AUTHORITY

The 42" water line from the City of Houston that feeds the water plant near Highway 3 for the Clear Lake City Water Authority is in the process of being repaired. Along with this, CLCWA has experienced a few main line breaks in its system and there is a high water demand from customers. These three issues combined compelled the Water Authority to enact the first stage of its Drought Contingency Plan, effective immediately. This stage calls for voluntary water conservation and requests that residents and businesses help by:

- Irrigating landscaped areas and lawns during the hours of midnight and 5 a.m.
- Not using water for washing cars, trucks, boats, or any type of vehicle.
- Not using water to flush gutters or fill amenity ponds.
- Not washing structures, sidewalks, or driveways.
- Reducing the filling of swimming pools, Jacuzzis/spas, and any other outdoor water use except during the hours above.
